Through a generous grant from the Burroughs Wellcome Fund, UMDF is offering a minimum of \$500 in scholarship support to qualifying researchers who are new to the field of mitochondrial research, to attend *Mitochondrial Medicine 2012-Washington DC*, June 13-16, 2012 at the Bethesda North Marriott Hotel & Conference Center, Bethesda, MD. Additional travel funding may be available, depending on the number of applicants and for foreign travel.

Requirements:

- Applicants must be at the beginning of their careers in research and who have yet to receive an NIH award.
- Applicants must have an expressed interest in pursuing mitochondrial disease research.
- Successful applicants must commit to writing a brief evaluation of the Symposium.

- Preference will be given to those who will commit to attending all four days of the Symposium.
- Researchers who are submitting abstracts and posters will also be given preference.
- International travel awards may be higher depending on costs.
